All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL—Funeral director's charges only (sum of the below) £3500

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements (Professional Charges)	£1735
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care (During Office Hours)	£265
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's premises in Llandudno Junction	£240
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from wood with real oak veneer - not foil or wood effect	£690
Viewing and preperation of the deceased person for family, by appointment with the funeral director in office hours (where viewing is requested)	£100
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or Crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£470

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director charges only) ¹	£on request
Cremation (funeral director charges plus cremation fee) ²	£1850

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee . ¹	
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:	£815-£2,063
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee . ²	
In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:	£514-£1350

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:

Limousine for funeral (including 20 miles, extra at £1 per mile)	£295
Additional mileage (price per mile)	£1
Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.)	from £125
Collection and delivery of ashes (within 20 miles of office)	£free
Embalming	from £150
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.)	£94-£250
Services supplied outside of normal office hours	Prices On Request

The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave and cost of purchasing grave if necessary

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
